Outdoor and Adventure

Trekking and Hiking

Trekking and hiking in Anatolia, which is surrounded on three sides by the sea, allows you to see Türkiye's unique natural beauty and ancient heritage. On your nature hikes, you'll pass by dozens of ancient cities and historical ruins, golden beaches that meet the turquoise sea, virgin bays hidden amidst forests, slopes of large mountains and high plateaus, canyons, and lesser-known caverns.

Mountain Climbing

Featuring an extraordinary variety of wildlife, flora and fauna, Türkiye's mountains offer exciting adventures for mountaineers. The country's most notable peaks are Mount Ağrı (5137 meters) in Eastern Anatolia and Mount Erciyes (3917 meters) in Central Anatolia. The Kaçkar Mountains (3932 meters) in the Black Sea coast and the Aladağlar mountain range in Niğde are other popular spots for mountain climbing, trekking and hiking.

Rafting

High mountains, long rivers, amazing green valleys and spectacular geography make Türkiye a real paradise for rafting and nature lovers. While you are on a rafting holiday in Türkiye, you will have a chance to white water raft down many great rivers and creeks.

The country abounds in mountains which give rise to rivers with swift currents and perilous rapids to titillate the experienced rafters. The Köprülü Canyon National Park in Antalya is known as the rafting center of Türkiye. Firtina River in Rize; Munzur Stream in Tunceli are among the other destinations for rafting enthusiasts.

The diving season is from June to September when the sea temperature is above 21°C and the seabed is repopulated over the winter. 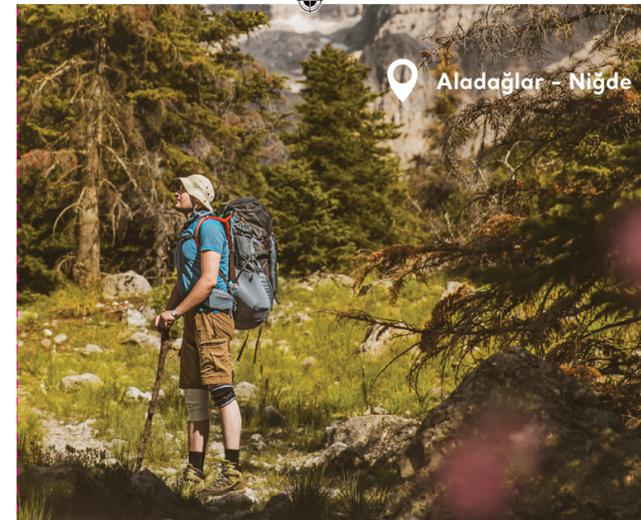
Windsurfing & Kitesurfing

The best spot for this sport is definitely Ölüdeniz, a slice of heaven located in the south of Fethiye. Ölüdeniz is a sheltered lagoon sandwiched between an exquisite beach and a lush national park. The Babadag Mountain, which is a one-hour drive from Ölüdeniz, offers perfect conditions for solo and tandem paragliding, as well as a stunning scenery which will take your breath away. Kaş is another great spot for paragliding in the Mediterranean region.

Caving

Türkiye is a true paradise for caving enthusiasts. Discovering the country's hidden caves is a thrilling adventure on its own. With its unique geography and more than 40,000 caves, Türkiye welcomes those who want to discover underground lakes, cisterns, stalactites and stalagmites.

Turkish Ministry of Culture and Tourism has opened 50 of the more than 40,000 of the nation's caves to visitors. Of these 50 caves, 31 are accessible to the general public while 12 require equipment and a guide for caving. Seven of these caves are only open to professionals.

Some of the prominent caves in Türkiye are Damlataş Cave in Alanya, İnsuyu Cave in Burdur, Karain Cave in Antalya, Gilindire Cave in Mersin province.

Canyoning
